This report provides you with the findings from the screening with any recommendations from the pediatric cardiologist that over-read your child's EKG and health history.

In the event that there is a recommendation to consult with a pediatric cardiologist, we will provide you a second email with additional instructions from our cardiology team.

Student Cardiac Screening Report

Your child, {Child's Name}, attended a free community heart screening sponsored by SafeBeat. The purpose of the screening is to identify conditions that lead to sudden cardiac arrest and death in children.

We conducted a brief physical exam consisting of: bi-lateral blood pressure, height and weight, auscultation, and an EKG. After considering all the screening information, including the medical and family history that you provided, a pediatric cardiologist from our medical team recommends the following:

You should consult with a Pediatric Cardiologist for further evaluation regarding the following for your child (you will be provided an additional email with instructions for follow up with our pediatric cardiology team):

LVH on EKG. You will be receiving a follow up email with further instructions.

This screening does not substitute for a regular, on-going relationship with your pediatrician, and no screening can identify 100% of individuals at risk for a sudden cardiac event. We encourage you and your child to have annual physicals, be familiar with the warning signs and symptoms of sudden cardiac arrest and discuss any health concerns or changes with your pediatrician or family physician.
